Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop hiring only 4 individuals. Total sales for that year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. Throughout 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide manufacturers within the material handling business.

Production and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the past sixty years, the material handling trade has developed into a highly advanced area and Cascade has proudly played a part on this progress. Cascade at present continues to develop as the premier supplier of forklift attachments and numerous related items. The business feels confident in their potential to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the international market.

Through the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to fabricate, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was made in 1956, so as to accommodate all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current head office. After 15 years of business, total employees reached 180 workers and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Plano the next manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Plano and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated internationally thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five firms, including the international best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
